

Flight 5 to Johannesburg

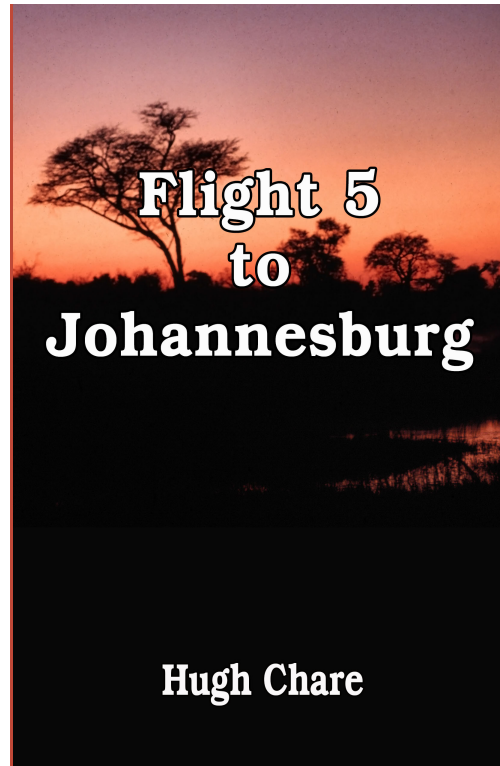
